PRESS RELEASE 07/29/2025

On July 26, 2025, a Seelyville Police Department officer conducting routine overnight patrol observed a vehicle traveling on Wabash Avenue exhibiting driving behavior consistent with possible driver impairment. After noting multiple traffic infractions, the officer initiated a traffic stop at the intersection of State Road 46 and Poplar Street.

During the preliminary investigation, the officer observed indicators of criminal activity within the vehicle, and the driver displayed signs of impairment. Assistance was requested by a Terre Haute Police Department K-9 officer. Following a positive K-9 indication on the vehicle, probable cause was established to conduct a search.

- 54.9 grams of suspected Methamphetamines
- 1.0 gram of prescription Narcotics (controlled substance)

The driver was offered and submitted to field sobriety testing on scene, which revealed additional signs of impairment. The driver was then offered but refused a certified chemical test and was taken into custody without further incident.

The driver was arrested for the following preliminary offenses:

Dealing in Methamphetamine, a Level 2 Felony; Possession of Methamphetamine (at least 28 grams), a Level 3 Felony; Possession of a Controlled Substance, a Class A Misdemeanor; Operating a Vehicle While Intoxicated, a Class C Misdemeanor.
