Agency Highlights

Personnel Updates

- Appointment of Town Marshal: Grant Daley
- Appointment of Deputy Marshal: Paul Barnes
- Appointment of Reserve Deputy Marshal: John Hendrix

Facility Improvements

- In September, the agency relocated to a secure facility offering expanded space and storage.
- The new location enhances the training environment, increases storage capacity, supports additional training opportunities, and ensures improved privacy for agency operations.

Fleet Expansion

- Acquisition of a fully outfitted 2025 Ford Explorer Police Interceptor Utility (PIU).
- This addition allows each of the three Marshals to be assigned an individual vehicle.

Technology & Cost Savings (Axon Contract)

- The Axon contract was renegotiated and restructured to better align with the needs of the Town and the agency.
- The revised agreement will result in cost savings for the Town over the next five years.

Equipment Upgrades

- All Marshals have been issued new ballistic vests with expiration dates extending to 2030.
- The Bulletproof Vest Partnership (BVP) Grant covered one-third of the vest costs.
- All personnel are now equipped with standardized, duty-appropriate equipment.

Ordinance Updates

- The Town of Seelyville Traffic Code was updated and published.
- More than six general ordinances were revised and published.
- Agency operations were coordinated in partnership with the Town Office and Clerk.

Revenue Generation

- The agency generated over \$4,000 in revenue through ordinance violations.

Operational Proactivity

- The agency more than doubled the number of calls for service compared to prior periods.
- These increases were managed while remaining within, and slightly under, the appropriated budget.

- **Calls for Service:** 1,332 (127% increase)
- **Assistance Calls for Service:** 274
- **Incident Reports:** 72
- **Arrests:** 49
- **Traffic Citations Issued:** 232
- **Traffic Warnings Issued:** 87

- **Ordinance Warnings:** 1
- **Vehicles Impounded:** 44
